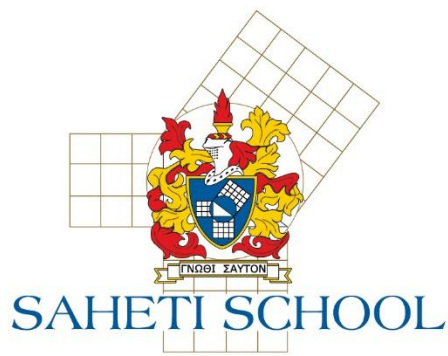




SUPPORT PLAN LESSONS 2026

Grade 10, 11 and 12 classes will follow the curriculum of Greek as a Second Additional Language (Matric Subject)

- Advanced Grades 6 + 7 (09:00 am – 12:00 pm)
- Adolescent Beginners Class (09:00am – 12:00pm)
- Preliminary Grades 8 + 9 / C. G. L. Greek (09:00 am – 11:00 am)
- Grade 10 /Greek as a second additional language (08:00 am – 10:00 am)
- Grade 11 /Greek as a second additional language (10:00 am – 12:00am)
- Grade 12 /Greek as a second additional language (08:00 am – 10:00pm)
